Operating Instructions - Twist-To-Lock Foot Ring

Foot Ring Adjustment

1. To adjust the twist-to-lock foot

ring, first the foot ring must be

loose, push down on the black

center collar to release the foot ring from its location (Figure 1).

 The foot ring is now free to move up or down the cylinder. Position the foot ring at a desired location and hold in place while going on to the next step (Detail A).

3. To lock the foot ring in place, push down on foot ring and allow the

black center collar to raise up.

Then while holding the 5-blade


base, turn the foot ring clockwise

slowly less than 1/8 of a turn until

engagement is felt and foot ring

loosened. Firmly hold the 5-blade

base so it does not rotate and turn the foot ring counter-clockwise less than $1/_8$ of a turn. Once it is



is snug. Do not over-tighten or under-tighten as poor function or damage can occur (Figure 2).
